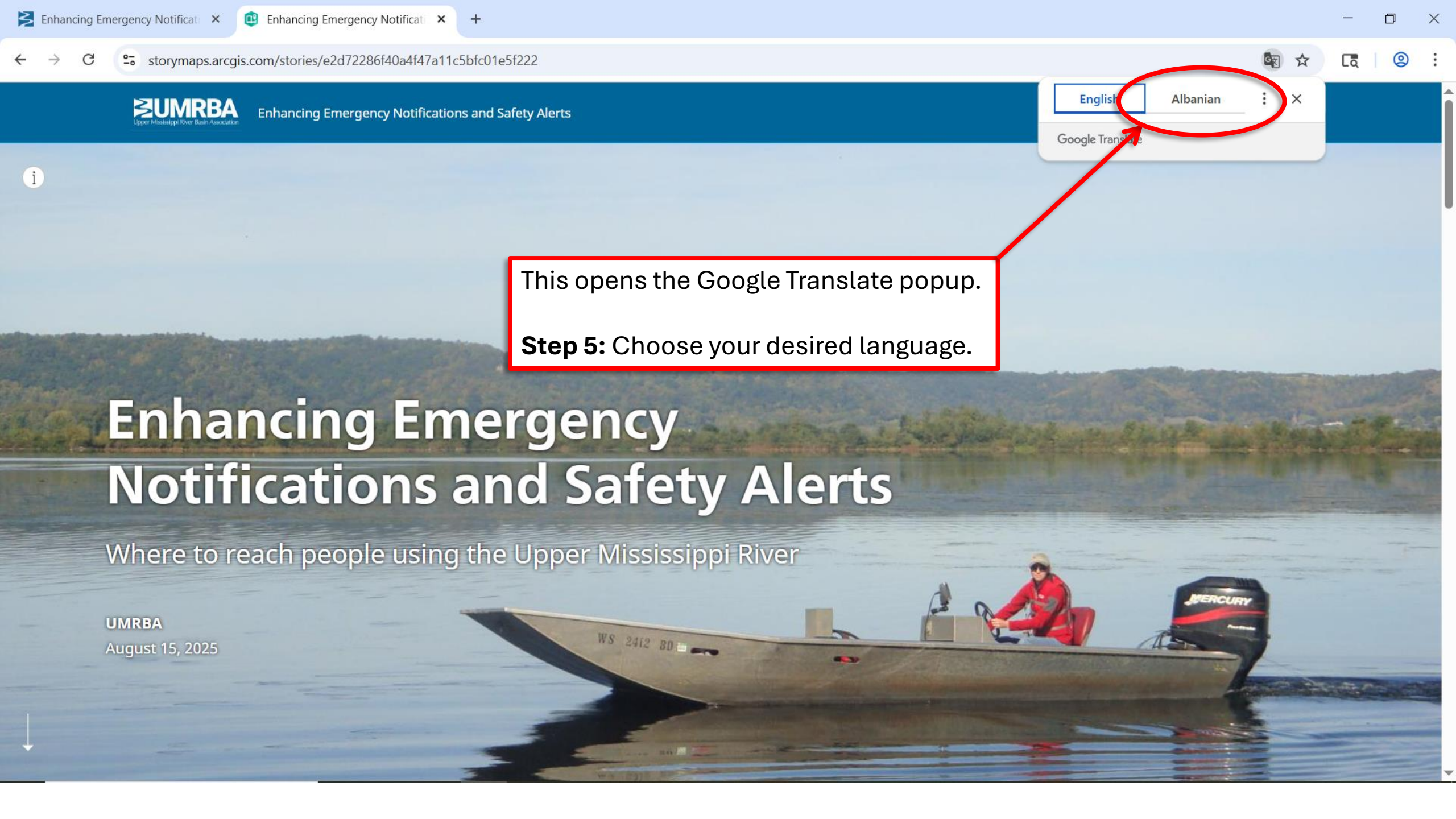

This opens the Google Translate popup.

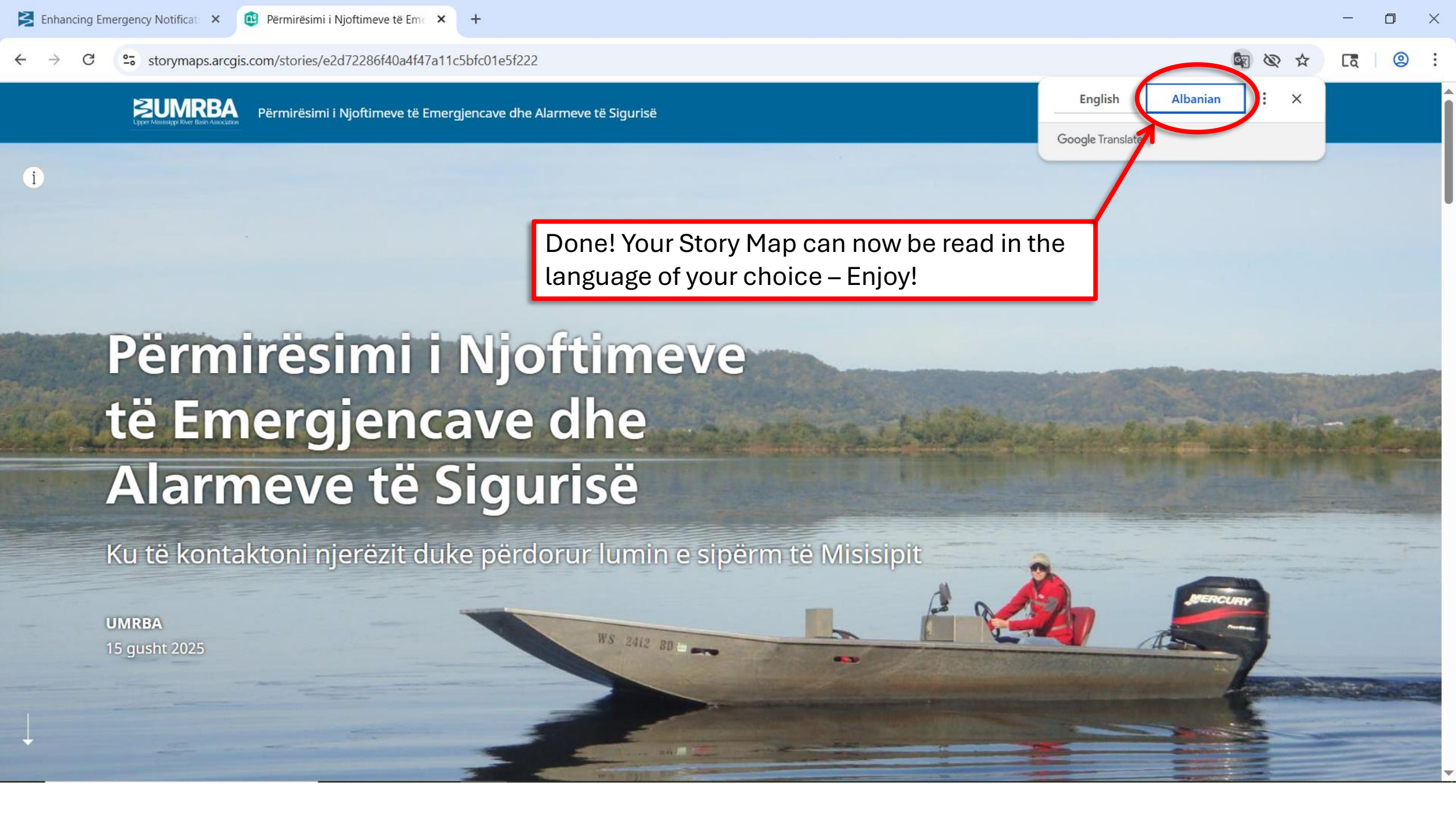
Step 5: Choose your desired language.
